1. Admission criteria

Applicants for the Bachelor of Social Science (Psychology) (Honours) must meet the following admission requirements.

- Completion of an Australian Psychology Accreditation Council (APAC) accredited undergraduate program within the previous five years with a Grade Point Average of no less than 5.5 in core level 2 and 3 psychology subjects of the accredited sequence.

OR

- Completion of an APAC-accredited graduate diploma program within the previous five years with a Grade Point Average of 5.5 excluding any introductory psychology subjects.

AND

- Completion of PSY301 Advanced Research Methods in Psychology OR PSY461 Advanced Research Methods in Psychology with Charles Sturt University or the equivalent from an APAC-accredited program.

English Language Proficiency

- An academic IELTS with a minimum score of 6 with no individual score below 5.5 or a qualification deemed by Charles Sturt to be equivalent as outlined in the Charles Sturt concordance table.

2. Supporting documentation

Applicants should provide the following.

- Evidence of your previous undergraduate degree if you are seeking entry based on your results in a Graduate Diploma of Psychology.
- A copy of the course structure from the university handbook identifying which subjects are core psychology subjects in the course (Charles Sturt graduates are not required to provide this).

AND

- A letter from your institution of study confirming that the course you have completed contains an APAC-accredited psychology sequence and that you are eligible to apply for fourth year programs.

OR

- Any other evidence to indicate that the course you have completed is an APAC-accredited three-year degree in psychology.

All documentation is to be submitted by the closing date, or as soon as possible after the closing date. The university may not be able to assess the eligibility of applicants whose transcripts are incomplete pending finalisation of subject grades. A certified copy of your academic transcript(s) MUST be enclosed. If you do not fulfil the above criteria, please note that you are not eligible for consideration for admission to this course.
