



## POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA OF PSYCHOLOGY

Admission to the Postgraduate Diploma of Psychology is competitive.

### 1. Admission criteria

Applicants for the Postgraduate Diploma of Psychology must meet the following admission requirements.

- Completion of an Australian Psychology Accreditation Council (APAC)-accredited three-year sequence (either an APAC-accredited undergraduate program or an APAC-accredited graduate diploma) within the previous 10 years.
- A grade point average of 5.0 or better in an APAC-accredited graduate diploma or in the core psychology level two and three subjects of an APAC-accredited undergraduate program.

AND

- The successful completion of PSY301 Advanced Research Methods in Psychology or PSY461 Advanced Research Methods in Psychology;

OR

- To have what is deemed to be the equivalent of the above three requirements from another institution.

English Language Proficiency

- An Academic IELTS with a minimum score of six with no individual score below 5.5 or a qualification deemed by Charles Sturt University to be equivalent as outlined in the Charles Sturt University concordance table.

### 2. Supporting documentation

Applicants should provide the following.

- Evidence of your previous undergraduate degree if you are seeking entry based on your results in a Graduate Diploma of Psychology.
- A copy of the course structure from the university handbook identifying which subjects are core psychology subjects in the course (Charles Sturt University graduates are not required to provide this).

AND

- A letter from your institution of study confirming that the course you have completed contains an APAC-accredited psychology sequence and that you are eligible to apply for fourth year programs.

OR

- Any other evidence to indicate that the degree you have completed is an APAC accredited three year of study in psychology.

To be considered in the main competitive round for this course, you must submit an application by the October closing date and provide evidence of completion of an APAC-accredited three-year sequence no later than the start of Session 3 of the same year.

Complete applications received after the October closing date, and applications submitted by the October closing date, but with evidence of completion of an APAC-accredited three-year sequence outstanding as at the start of Session 3, will only be considered where places remain available after the main competitive round has been completed.
